- ii. Waste Management in Offices.**
  - a. All UTCL plants have waste management system in office & colony.

  - d. Mentioned hazardous waste disposal to vendors auth. by State/Central PCBs with proper documentation, labeling
- vi. Recycling & Reuse of Waste**
  - a. Due focus on recycling, re-use and minimal waste across process/systems
  - b. Material spilled from Belt conveyor/air slide etc. reused by feedback system
  - c. Fly Ash generated in Thermal Plant used in Cement Manufacturing Ops
  - d. Waste water is treated and re-used in gardening/dust suppression

  - a. At our plants washrooms are made available for all workers and urge them to use the same.
  - b. Talks, Road Shows, Street Plays by CSR/medical team/students for healthy sanitation awareness.
  - c. Display board at different location related to water, sanitation and hygienic condition.
  - d. Safety and Cleanliness awareness in our Off The Job Safety programs
- ix. Industry's role in generating awareness about sanitation and its linkage with public health**
  - a. Awareness sessions and cleanliness drives incorporating community people
  - b. Youth groups & ladies have been engaged in events with the help of Public health department and panchayats to spread awareness about health, hygiene & sanitation to develop villages.
- x. Industry's role in eradication of manual scavenging & elimination of open defecation.**
  - c. At all our plants No Manual Scavenging is being done.
  - d. We conduct regular awareness session for the workers being conducted to use toilets.
  - e. Discuss and participate with local administration for elimination of open defecation
  - f. Spreading awareness in the community for constructing sanitation blocks & emphasizing on personal hygiene.

## Swachh Bharat Abhiyan

UltraTech has been actively associated with Habitat for Humanity on “Swachh Bharat Abhiyan” by supplying cement for construction of 922 sanitation units for low income families in selected villages of Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh.

### Waste management in the offices

1. All UTCL plants have waste management system in office & colony.
2. Employees are made aware of ‘Swachh Bharat Abhiyan’.
3. In the Monthly meet, Unit Head sensitizes all for maintaining green & clean environment.
4. Organization is focussed to reduce Paper Usage with a series of initiatives such as –
  - Online systems for TA Bills, Salary slips, purchase requisitions;
  - Reduction of printers and usage of common printers;
  - Promoting Online correspondence and use of scans vs printouts
  - Use of Ceramic, glassware, steelware instead of paper or plastic cups

### Segregation of Waste Collection

1. System of collecting different types of wastes at Source itself by having different colored collection bins.
2. Non-compostable wastes (metals/wood etc) is collected and disposed to Scrap dealers for recycle or reuse.
3. Other select wastes are segregated in a yard. They are shredded, co-processed in kiln in an environment friendly manner.
4. Daily collection of Colony Garbage waste. Kitchen waste sent to Nursery for vermi-compost.
